Christmas in a Shoebox: It has been an amazing effort again this year and with the donations from the English-speaking Community almost 400 boxes are on their way to Eastern Europe.

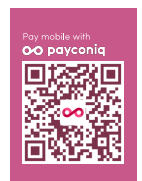
